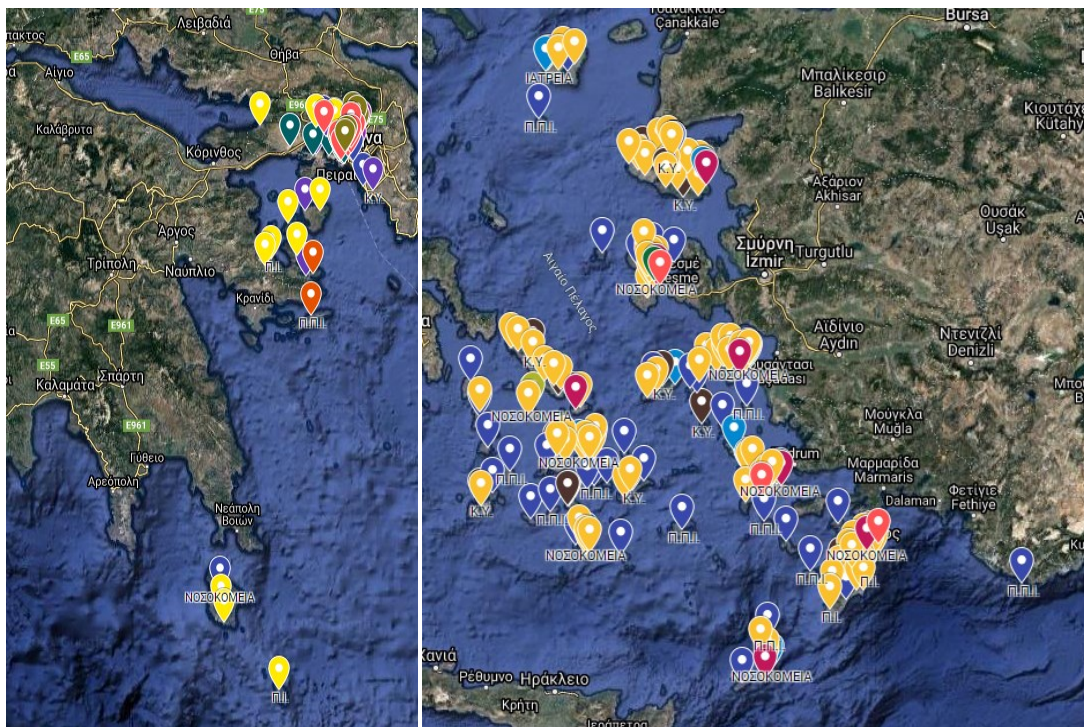
**The geographical area of responsibility** for the 2nd Regional Health Authority of Piraeus and Aegean Islands (2nd DYPE) encompasses a diverse and expansive territory, including:

- **Western Athens:** Covering the western region of the Greek capital, Athens, and its surrounding suburban areas.
- **Western Attika:** Encompassing the western portion of the Attica region, extending beyond the boundaries of the city of Athens.

- Piraeus: Including the port city of Piraeus, a major hub of commerce and transportation in Greece.
- Attika islands: Encompassing the islands located within the Attica region, such as Salamis, Aegina, and Poros.
- Northern Aegean Islands: Including islands such as Lesbos, Chios, and Samos, situated in the northern Aegean Sea.
- Southern Aegean Islands: Encompassing islands such as Rhodes, Kos, and Santorini, located in the southern Aegean Sea.

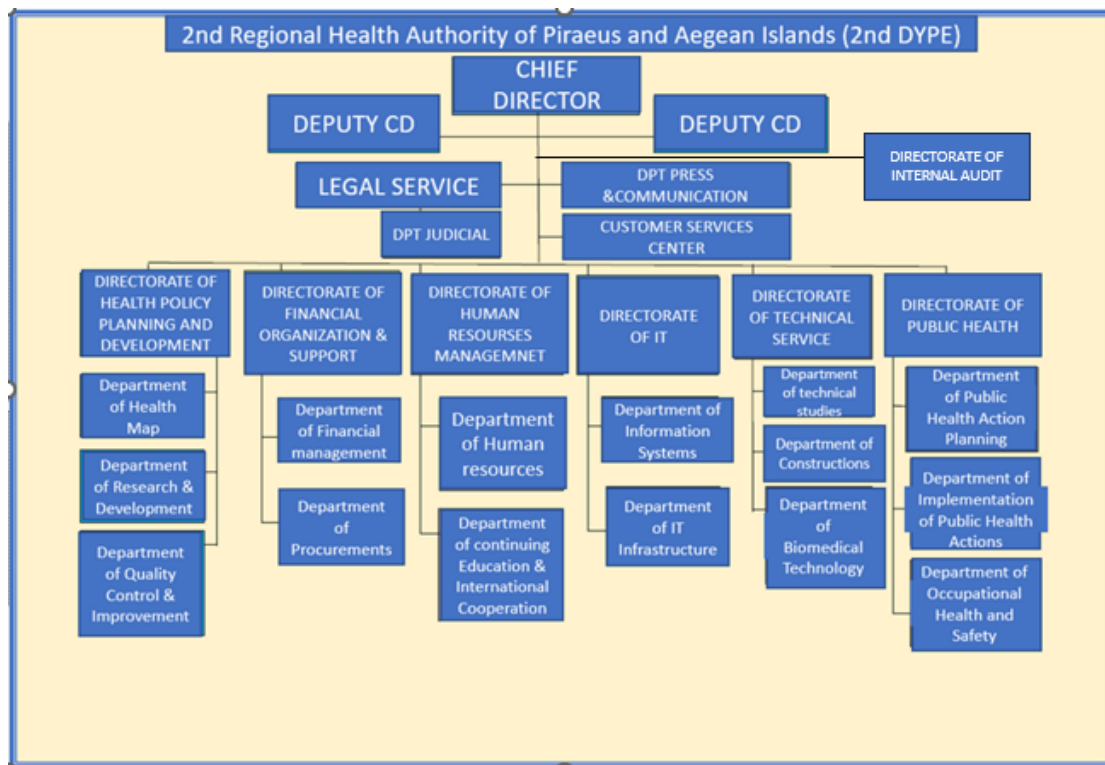
This geographical area is further characterized by its administrative division into 74 municipalities, which are scattered across 3 Regional Authorities and 25 regional units. This distribution reflects the diverse population centers and communities served by the 2nd DYPE, each with its own unique health needs and challenges.

Through strategic planning, coordination, and oversight, the 2nd DYPE endeavors to ensure the provision of comprehensive and equitable healthcare services to the residents of its geographical area of responsibility, promoting the health and well-being of all individuals and communities within its purview.



## Organizational Structure

The organizational chart below illustrates the hierarchical structure of the 2nd DYPE, delineating the various departments and units responsible for the execution of our mission and the achievement of our objectives. Through strategic alignment and effective coordination, we harness the collective expertise and resources of our organization to fulfill our mandate and serve the health needs of our communities.



The 2nd Regional Health Authority of Piraeus and Aegean Islands (2nd DYPE) exercises supervision over a comprehensive network of healthcare facilities and structures, including:

- (24) NHS Hospitals: Oversight of National Health System hospitals, ensuring adherence to quality standards and efficient service delivery.
- (49) Health Centers (HC): Supervision of primary health care centers, serving as pivotal points for community-based healthcare services.
- (6) Mental Health Centers (MHC): Monitoring of specialized centers dedicated to mental health care and support.
- (40) Multifunctional Regional Clinics (MRC): Coordination and oversight of clinics offering a range of medical services to the local population.

- (128) Regional Clinics (P.I.): Management and supervision of regional clinics providing specialized medical care and treatments.
- (14) Local Clinics (T.I.): Supervision of clinics at the local level, offering essential healthcare services to residents.
- (10) Special Regional Clinics (E.Π.I.): Regulation and oversight of specialized clinics addressing specific healthcare needs within the region.
- (20) Local Health Groups (T.OM.Y.): Coordination and supervision of local health groups, facilitating community-based health promotion and preventive care initiatives.

Through diligent supervision and strategic coordination of these healthcare structures, the 2nd DYPE endeavors to ensure the provision of accessible, high-quality healthcare services to the population it serves, promoting better health outcomes and overall well-being.
